





### Oceans hold Carbon Dioxide



### **Ocean Acidification**

The ocean takes up Carbon dioxide, this CO2 reacts with the water to make carbonic acid - this acid releases Hydrogen ions which react with carbonate ions to make bicarbonate. This doesn't leave any carbonate ions for shelled animals to use to make their shells.
